You've probably seen this method already but check out the TaPHSiC method in addition to the filter here: [Tool 10: Extra Strong Fences - TaPhSiC Method \(guardyoureyes.com\)](https://guardyoureyes.com) Just in case you come across loopholes in your filter which you can't immediately fix as it leaves you in a vulnerable situation to go and exploit it. It happened to me that when I found a loophole, which I wasn't even trying to look for, that I gave into watching. The TaPHSiC method would've saved me from that as I fixed that loophole the very next day so

all I had to do was last one day.
